

## LARGE-FORMAT PRINTING: EPSON STYLUS PRO

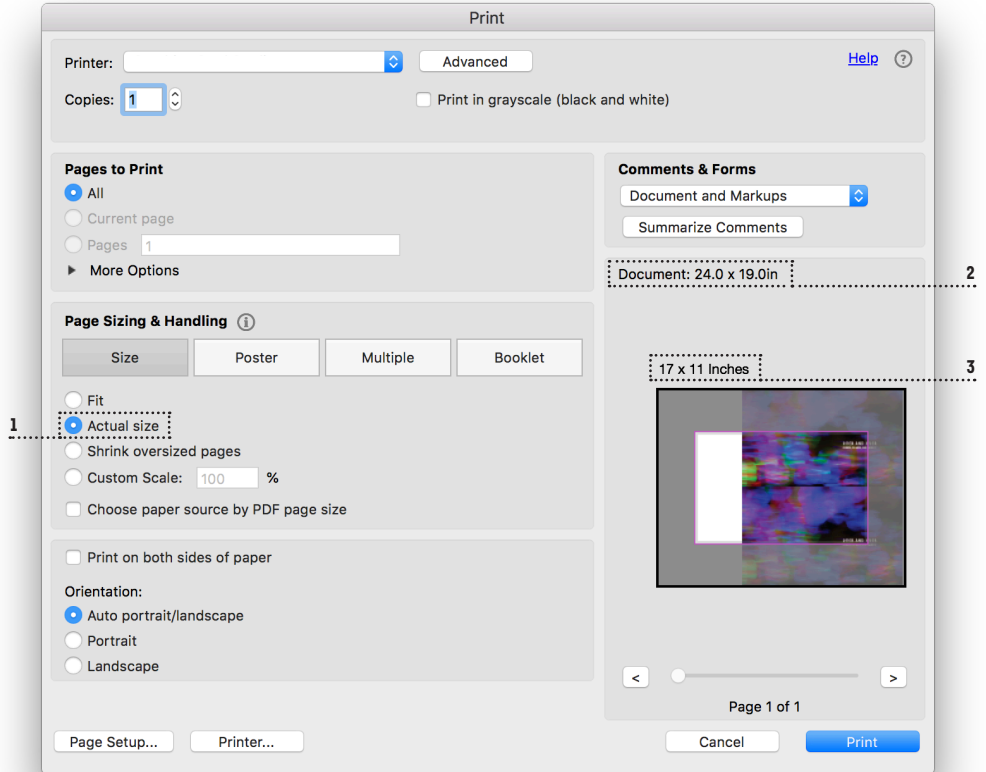
### ACROBAT PRO: Printing from a PDF

#### Basic Options

Select the Printer that you will be using. Match the name and number when selecting a printer, and ensure that the printer you choose has the desired paper loaded (i.e. Enhanced Matte paper).

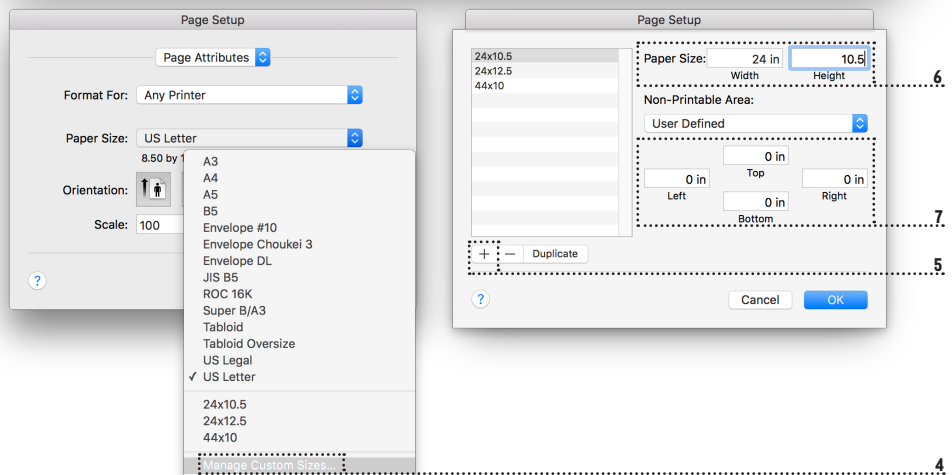
In the print dialog:

1. Check "Actual size" under Page Sizing & Handling
2. Note the document size measurement provided to you over the preview thumbnail  
"Document: 00 x 00 in"
3. And, note the paper size measurement below that. You will need to change this based on the document measurement.

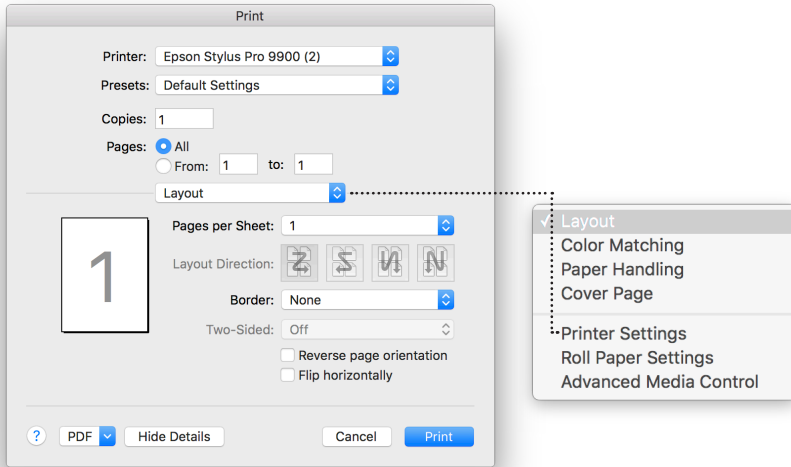


#### Page Setup

4. Click Page Setup, then select Paper Size > Manage Custom Sizes...
5. Click the plus button to add a new custom size.
6. Enter the physical size of the print.  
**Width:** Should be 0.5 inches larger than the document width, but less than paper roll width (24, 26, or 44).  
**Height:** Should be 0.5 inches larger than the document height from step #2, and at least 5 inches long.  
**Borderless width:** If your print is the same size as the roll, you can add 0.23 inches (24.23 inches) to skip the later step, "Retain Size."
7. Zero out the non-printable area sizes. They do not apply to the Epson Stylus Pro printers.

### Printer Settings

8. After confirming Page Setup, click the Printer button on the main printing dialog.
9. Change the dropdown menu from Layout to Printer Settings.
10. Select or confirm the following options:

**Page Setup:** Change Borderless (Auto Expand) to Roller Paper.

Do not use Auto Expand for design work, especially when trimming to an exact size. Auto Expand is only appropriate for full-bleed photographs.

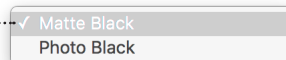
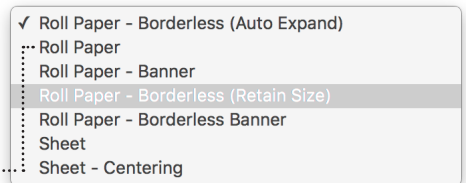
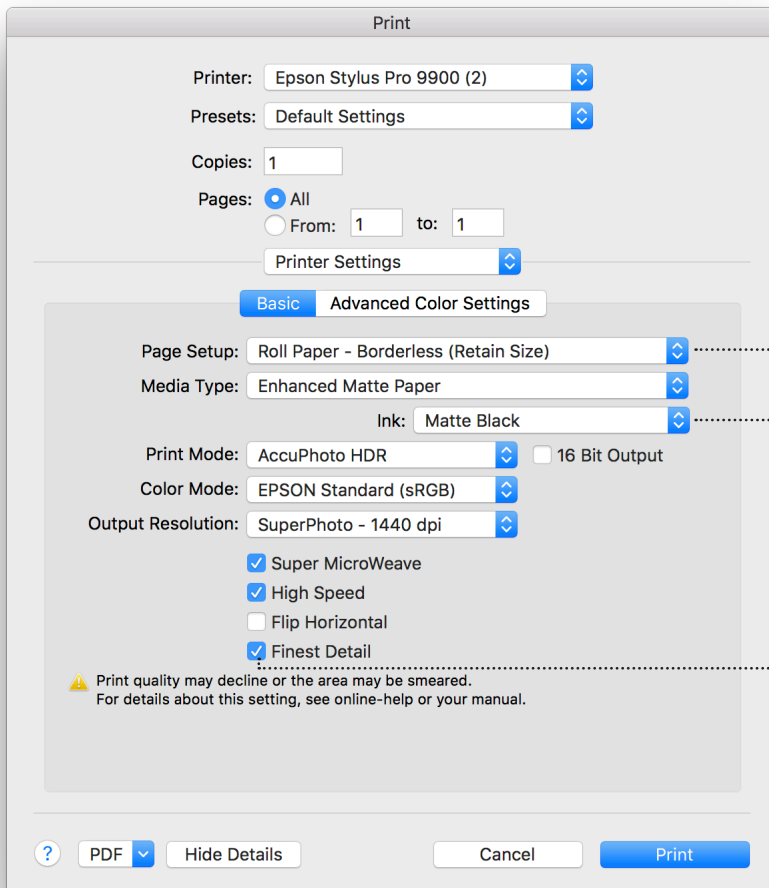
If you are using a sheet instead of a roll of paper, select that here.

If you are printing borderless, ensure your page size settings are correct and select Borderless (Retain Size).

**Ink:** Ink type must match paper type. Use Matte Black ink with Matte Paper.

**Color Mode:** If you have done color matching or are using a specific color profile, you can change how colors are rendered here and in the Color Matching menu.

Color management settings must agree between driver settings (here) and application settings. (Printer manages color, Acrobat manages color, etc).



**Finest Detail:** Printing type and vectors? Then check this option. Though your print will take slightly longer to finish, this will help reduce stair-stepping (aliasing) of crisp, hard edges in vector graphics and typography.
